Cash Spent Column: Enter actual money spent for gifts, gift cards, supplies for making other items, literature, distribution, postage and shipping, etc. Base value of handmade items on the actual cost of materials used, not on the retail value of the finished product. The Cash Spent report is recognized in lieu of actual money placed in the offering. It must show only cash spent, not cash value. No value is to be reported on used items.

Local Column: Enter approved project for local church, parsonage and pastor's family; cost of literature and Bibles distributed locally; community benevolences include food for the needy, bereaved or emergency assistance. Do not report food for local church or sectional fellowship meetings, weddings, baby showers, etc.
