Prayer Time-line



Please pray daily one month before the conference.
"The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective."
James 5:16



October 15 – Pray that our eyes are fixed on Jesus Christ during all preparation for the conference and that nothing would compete with His Lordship in any way.

Hebrews 12:2 "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith.

Colossians 1:28 "He is the head of the body, the church; He is the beginning and the end...that in everything He might have supremacy."

October 16 – Pray that God would draw women of all backgrounds, ages and across denominational lines to attend this conference. Pray for God to provide the finances for all those who desire to come.

John 6:44 "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him."

Matthew 6:8 "...your Father knows what you need before you ask Him."

October 17 – Pray that God would move in the hearts of area pastors and women's leaders to encourage their women to come. Pray for divine appointments and boldness for women to personally invite friends, neighbors and co-workers.

Proverbs 16:9 "In his heart a man plans his course, but the Lord determines his steps."

Ephesians 6:19 "Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel.... Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should."

October 18 – Pray that all those involved in the preparation and orchestration of the conference will have the mind of Christ so that we would operate in a spirit of unity. Pray that there would be no division, that all will be perfectly united in word and thought.

Isaiah 11:2 "The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord."

Ephesians 4:3 "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."

October 19 – Pray that nothing would be done in the flesh but in the power of the Holy Spirit.

Zachariah 4:6 "...not by might or by power but by My Spirit says the Lord Almighty."

I Corinthians 14:40 "But everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way."

October 20 – Pray for our speakers, Valorie Burton, Sheri Rose Shepherd, Dannah Gresh, and Ruth Puleo, to draw close to the Father’s heart and that He would put His words in their mouths. Pray that God would reveal His perfect will to them as they seek Him.

1 Peter 4:11 “If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God...so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.”

October 21 – Pray that Stephanie Peters and the worship team will be in one accord as they prepare to usher us into His presence. Pray for clear direction as the songs are chosen and rehearsed and that the Holy Spirit would lead our times of worship together, bringing glory, honor and praise to our Heavenly Father.

Isaiah 57:14 “Build up, build up, prepare the road! Remove the obstacles out of the way of my people!”

Isaiah 62:10 “Pass through, pass through the gates. Prepare the way for the people...”

October 22 – Pray as the Word is shared at “Refresh & Refuel” by Valorie Burton, Sheri Rose Shepherd and Dannah Gresh, that those who hear will be encouraged and receive new vision and refreshing.

Hebrews 4:12 “For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than a double edged sword. It penetrates even to dividing sword and spirit...judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart...nothing is hidden from God’s sight...”

October 23 - Pray that pride will be broken and that each woman will deal with her sins through repentance and seeking forgiveness.”

Isaiah 57:15 “For this is what the high and lofty One says... I live in a high and holy place but also with him who is contrite and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly and to revive the heart of the contrite.”

October 24 – Pray for the women to be friendly, to consider others above themselves, and to see relationships furthered. Pray that women would feel connected to God and to each other during the conference; no one feeling alone or isolated.

Philippians 2:3-4 “Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interest of others.”

October 25 – Pray that women will hunger and thirst for righteousness and that God will bring tenderness and receptivity to His Word and each one will be challenged to respond. Pray that He will receive all the glory for the work He will accomplish in hearts that are yielded to Him.

Matthew 5:6 “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness for they shall be filled.”

October 26 – Pray for those deciding to attend, that God would stir their hearts and open the way. Pray that no weapon formed against the conference will prosper.

Isaiah 54:17 “No weapon forged against you will prevail and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord...”

October 27 – Pray for Ruth Puleo and her heart for missions. Pray for women to have a heart for missions as well and to be inspired to give generously to the project offering for the women’s center in Burkina Faso, West Africa.

Matthew 25:40 “The King will reply, I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did it for me.”

October 28 – Pray God will open women’s eyes to the amazing gifts He has placed within them and equip them with courage to use their gifts for Him.

Ephesians 1:18 “ I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints.”

October 29 – Pray that God will plant seeds, water the seeds, grow the seeds, and that He will tend the gardens of our hearts and minds and bring a bountiful harvest from the time at the conference.

I Corinthians 3:6, 8 “I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow. The man who plants and the man who waters have one purpose and each will be rewarded according to his own labor.”

October 30 – Pray for the younger women who attend to see a nurturing, caring spirit among the women.

Hebrews 13:20-21 “May the God of peace...equip you with everything good for doing His will, and may He work in us what is pleasing to Him.”

October 31 – Pray for our featured guest, Anne Beiler, as she shares about her ministry and that it will speak to the ladies to see the plans He has for them in their lives.

Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

November 1 – Pray for the soloists, Vicki Yohe and Judge Cheryl Allen, that through their anointed singing, God will draw the ladies into His presence and minister His peace.

Psalms 28:7 “The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song.”

November 2 – Pray for protection for all the special guests as they travel. Pray for their families as they are away from them while at the conference.

Job 1:10 “Have you not put a hedge around him and his household and everything he has?”

November 3 – Pray for all the women traveling to the conference for protection and to have a great time of fellowship with their friends. Pray for their families as they are away from them this weekend.

Psalms 34:7 “The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them.”

November 4 – Pray for freedom for the speakers, worship team and all who attend that God will set all free and that His joy will come to each one.

John 8:32 “Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

John 8:36 “So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.”

November 5 – Pray for the Prayer Team as they minister at the altars and pray with the women that God's anointing will be on their lives.

Ephesians 6:18 "And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints."

November 6 – Pray that God's Word will be spiritual food for those who are malnourished spiritually. Pray that the spiritual eyes of the women will be opened as they are fed the Word.

I Peter 2:2-3 "...as newborn babies desire the pure milk of the Word, that you may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious."

November 7 – Pray that walls of the women's hearts will be broken down and a spirit of freedom and praise will enter their hearts.

Isaiah 60:18 "You will call your walls salvation and your gates praise."

November 8 – Pray for the technical team and all aspects to operate smoothly for sound, lighting and video.

Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

November 9 – Pray that our conduct and presence would be a testimony to the employees at the hotel and restaurants and all we come in contact with.

Philippians 2:5 "Your attitude should be the same as Christ."

November 10 – Pray that women will be changed and leave the conference determined to be a light in their community and to their family and friends.

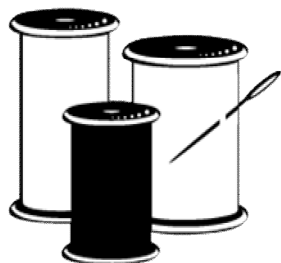
Matthew 5:16 "...let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works..."
